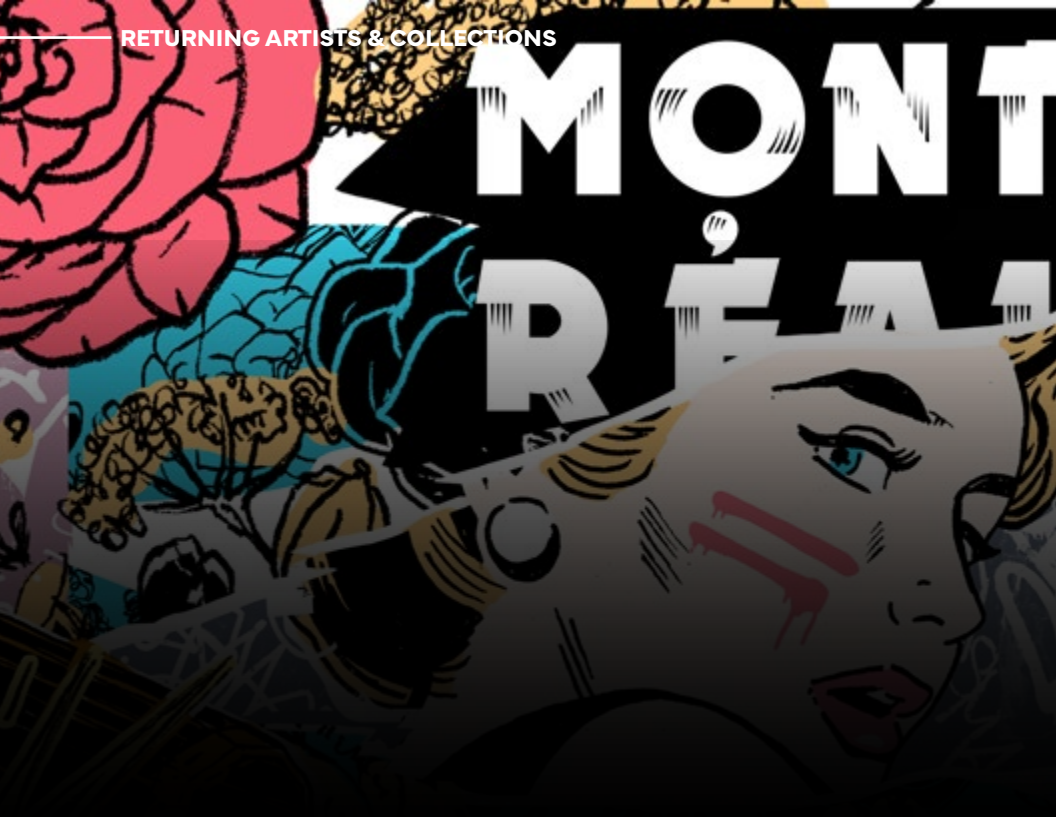
Simon Lam

We offer our wallpaper designs in materials for residential, commercial environments and public spaces.

Our standard wallpaper rolls vary from 26 to 32 inches wide and our commercial rolls are available in 52 inches wide.

Our patterns are primarily a straight match, but we can also produce custom roll lengths. This allows our clients to order only the length they need to reduce waste. We aim for as little of our wallpaper as possible to end up in landfills.
